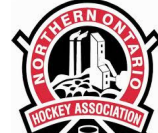

The 2016-17 season saw two of our teams listed in the final CJHL Top 20 rankings of the campaign, including our defending NOJHL champion Powassan Voodooos.

We as a league have also seen well over 100 players, coaches, officials and team staff members advance to the next level be it through NCAA or CIS programs as well via the Canadian Hockey League along with various other elite-level programs and conferences.

The NOJHL Showcase will again provide two days of exciting on-ice action with a total of 12 games being contested at one venue, which will along you the opportunity to scout all of our players, at the Gerry McCrory Countryside Sports Complex in Sudbury.
